September 5, 2023

Mayor Cook called the Utility Board Meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. In attendance were Vice Mayor Jones, Councilmember Edwards, Councilmember Collyer, Councilmember Seewald, and Town Manager Resele.

Review and Approval of Agenda

Vice Mayor Jones made a motion to approve the agenda as amended.

Town Manager Report

Sewer Credit Request

21138 Striper Run – There was a discussion, and it was decided that further information was needed and will be discussed again at the Regular Business Meeting on September 14th.

<u>Water Main Update</u>

Repairs were made in the following areas:

Lawton Avenue, Sharp Street, Hynson Road, Coleman Road and South Main Street.

Collection System Update

Pump Station #2 went down and has been repaired.

Utility Projects

Water Line Replacement – Haven Road

Project has started and is proceeding as time.

The additional funding paperwork has been turned into CDBG.

Still waiting for a permit from MDE to change from gas chlorine to liquid chlorine.

Hydrant Flushing will start on September 18th, 19th, and 20th. Maryland Rural Water will help with this process.

<u>Sewer Plant</u>

Rapid Mix Motor was repaired for \$2,220.96.

Councilmember Seewald made a motion to approve \$2,220.96 for the repair of the Rapid Mix Motor. Vice Mayor Jones seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Water Plant

The Chlorine Vapor Alarm failed and was repaired.

Councilmember Collyer made a motion to approve \$1,432.50 for the repair to the Chlorine Vapor Alarm. Vice Mayor Jones seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Old Business

Wastewater Pretreatment Program – Ordinance will be introduced on September 14, 2023.
